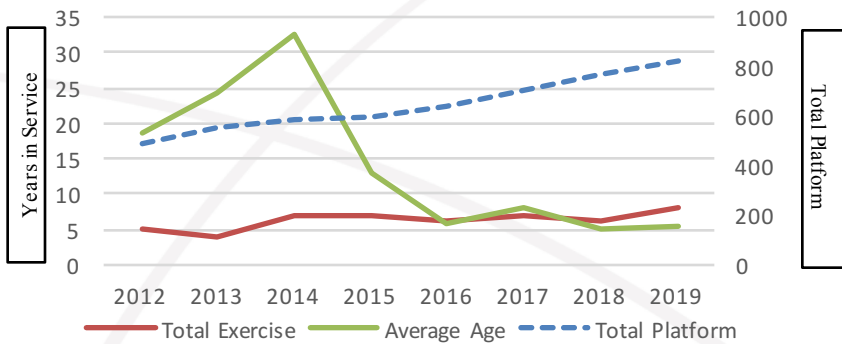
Readiness

TNI AU's Jetfighter in Exercise 2009-2019

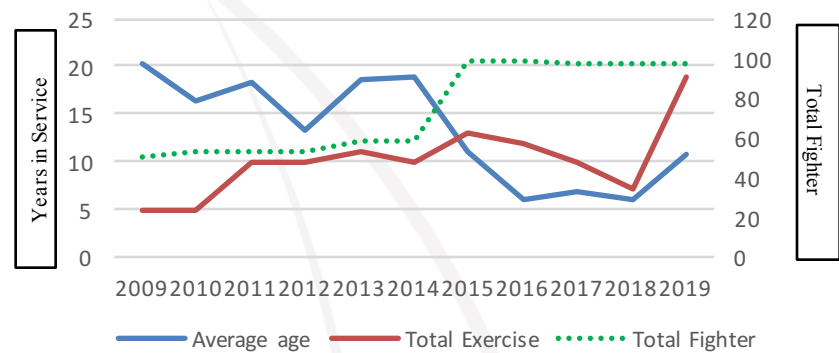
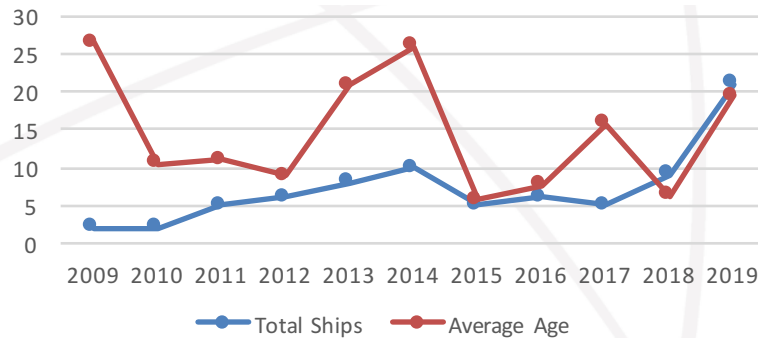


Figure 5: TNI AL's Warships in Exercise 2009-2019

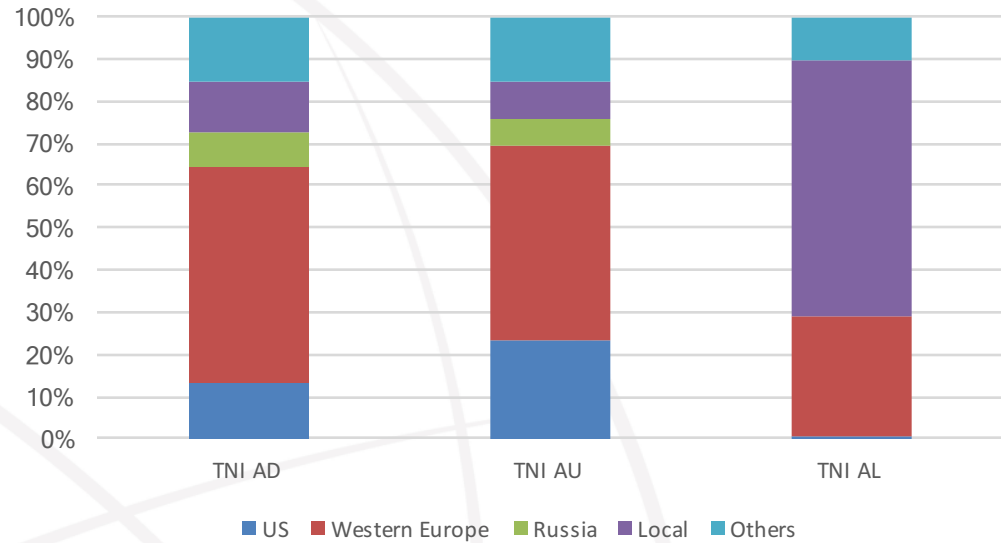


Mixed-Bag Procurement

As of January 2020



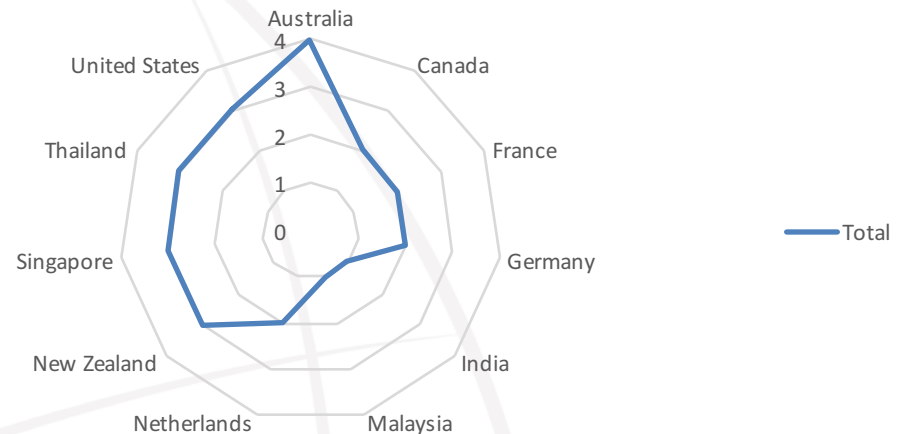
Practical Discrepancy
